

What is a jichikai?

A jichikai is an autonomous community organization formed and maintained by the residents living in that community. In Saitama City, these organizations go by different names, including 'jichi-kyoryoku-kai' and 'chonaikai', but can all be referred to as jichikai.

(There are 859 jichikai in Saitama City as of April 1, 2018)

The Great East Japan Earthquake has reminded us of the importance of community support. Jichikai carry out various activities to deepen community relationships as community connections are the most reliable when a disaster occurs. We believe daily activities lead to security during emergency situations.
